In 2008, China imported 42.24 million tons of scraps. From January 2009 to September 2009, 42.5927 million tons of scraps were imported, with 32.03 percent increasing compared to the same period of last year. It is estimated that 2009 import volume will exceed last year. Imported scraps have become an important way to solve inadequate resources and also a strategic measure to make up shortage of resources in China. However, some phenomenon occurred when imported solid scrap, which did not meet China's laws and regulations.

In order to further regulate renewable resources import, promote the healthy development of imported renewable resources, imports, publicize China's related policies and regulations, enhance domestic and oversea enterprises know and enforce the policies and regulations and strengthen trade exchange between domestic consignees and foreign suppliers, China International Scrap Conference will be held.
