Environmental artist Nancy Judd is launching her third Recycle Runway Exhibit, this time in Phoenix Sky Harbor International Airport, displaying her one-of-a-kind, award-winning recycled fashions from February 13, 2010 through August 8, 2010. Preview all the garments at www.RecycleRunway.com.

Nancy Judd will give presentations on the environment and her collection of trashique to youth groups in Phoenix while she is in town the week of February 8, 2010.

Nancy Judd describes her work as follows: **"My goal is to change the way people live on the earth.** We each make choices everyday that either help to solve the environmental crisis, or intensify it.

I don't expect people to make their own clothes from trash! However, I do hope to inspire eco-leaders... people who creatively find ways to care for the earth by making thoughtful choices at work, at home, at school, at church and in their communities

I reach millions of people around the world through airport installations, youth presentations and media coverage. My glamorous fashions made from garbage encourage people to look differently at trash. For me, waste does not exist, only wasted resources."

Recycle Runway is a traveling exhibit of custom-designed recycled garments showcased around the country to promote sustainability. The next exhibit will be in the Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport and will display 20 garments in 9 cases located throughout International Concourse E.

Commissioned by global organizations including Toyota®, Target®, Coca-Cola®, and the Glass Packaging Institute, the Recycle Runway garments were created to showcase the creativity of sustainability by combining the art of haute couture and environmental education.

Environmental educator, artist, and recycling consultant, Nancy Judd, began making her artistic creations in 2000. She has been the Recycling Coordinator for the City of Santa Fe, New Mexico, and the Executive Director of the New Mexico Recycling Coalition, and founded the Recycle Santa Fe Art Market and Fashion show in 1998.
